


# **ALEX HAWKE IS BACK!**

Author Ryan Steck Signs Two-Book Deal to Takeover Ted Bell's Beloved New York Times Bestselling Alex Hawke Series





### Who Is Ryan Steck?



Ryan Steck (pictured above wearing Ted Bell's yellow watch, the same watch Bell wore in his author photo for his last novel, *Sea Hawke*) is an author, freelance editor, and founder of *The Real Book Spy*. His debut novel, *Fields of Fire*, the first book in his Matthew Redd thriller series, was released in 2021. His second book, *Lethal Range* came out earlier this year. His third novel, *Out of Blood*, is scheduled to hit bookstores on June 4th, 2024, and is currently available for pre-order wherever books are sold.

Readers who want to get to know Ryan's work can start with any of his full-length novels. He also has a brand new novella that came out today, just in time for the Holiday season, called *<u>Redd Christmas</u>*.

As a novelist, Ryan's work has been endorsed by #1 *New York Times* bestselling authors such as Jack Carr, Nelson DeMille, C.J. Box, Mark Greaney, James Rollins, Kyle Mills, and more. As the Real Book Spy, an industry insider and literary critic, Steck—who was also named an "online influencer" by Amazon in 2018—has received praise from Lisa Scottoline, Brad Thor, Daniel Silva, Janet Evanovich, Steve Berry, Don Winslow, and many more.

But more importantly, and what Alex Hawke fans should know, is that for the last decade, Ryan has worked with Ted behind the scenes in various roles. Moreover, Ted singled Steck out in the acknowledgments of his 2020 novel *Dragonfire*, writing:

"Ryan Steck. A Name known by any and all who labor in the vineyards of the thriller novel. Besides his encyclopedic knowledge of the genre, Ryan is a book doctor extraordinaire, an editor, and a huge promoter of us pencil pushers. More importantly, I will acknowledge his huge contribution to all of us. When I came of age in this thriller game, there was a pervasive air of competition between all of us writers. A given. While I don't want to give too much of the story away just yet, I am already hard at work on MONARCH, a high-flying tale that pulls Hawke—who has only recently started to settle down and try his hand at being a family man—back into the life of action, while also testing him in ways he never could have imagined. The plot, which I constructed from many past conversations with Ted, is something I believe he would have loved and probably written himself. "A good story needs the three Bs," Ted would often tell me, "bullets, babes, and bad guys," and his readers can rest assured that they'll find plenty of all three in MONARCH when it hits store shelves in 2025."
